COSTUME REQUIREMENTS:

CAST MEMBERS: The majority of students should be dressed as tourists. They're becoming world travelers! Think Hawaiian shirts, leis, khaki shorts, graphic t-shirts with silly designs/travel logos, fanny packs, etc. We are allowing hats and sunglasses, but please be sure they are secure for their dance and do not block anyone behind/around them on stage.

The only students who should be dressed differently are our COUNTRY GUIDES (Hana, Omar, and Lucia). If you have been cast as these parts, please dress in a scholarly fashion: suits, dresses, tweed jackets, glasses, etc. DO NOT dress as the country you're portraying. Understudies should dress in the tourist outfits.

SKIRTS – Must have shorts/leggings underneath **SHOES** – Students will be barefoot, unless they have nude or black jazz shoes. Named characters included. Please consider this when planning costuming.

The most important part of costuming is to make sure all friends are still able to move comfortably for their class's dance and they're not blocking other friends while on the risers.

PLEASE READ: Showcase performances are a highlight of our year here at the Hawn and really show off the heart of this special performing arts school. If your child is not at the performance, they will miss a valuable grade for Dance, Drama, and Music. 3 equivalent makeup assignments will be provided to them should they not attend.
